Harley J. McKee Award Recipients

The Harley J. McKee Award is the highest honor bestowed by APT. It recognizes individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the field of preservation technology. These contributions may be in any preservation discipline, including education. The award is chosen at the President's discretion and is given annually at the APT conference. First presented in 1985, this award is named for the late Harley J. McKee who was the second president of APT and a professor of architecture, most remembered for his 21-year teaching career at Syracuse University. His book, *Introduction to Early American Masonry: Stone, Brick, Mortar and Plaster*, is considered an essential resource for students of historic preservation. In 2017, APT published a new edition of the book.
