The process of peer reviewing articles is critical to the *APT Bulletin* as a scholarly journal. It helps us understand whether sound preservation practices were followed in a project, whether the ideas proposed or the research conducted are original, and whether a paper would make a valuable contribution to the field. Peer reviewers gain an early look at the latest work and have a hand in shaping the information that is disseminated about preservation's best practices. Without the expertise of reviewers, the *APT Bulletin* would not be able to offer the forward-looking information that our audience has come to expect.

The peer-review process is straightforward. As articles come in, we alert potential peer reviewers by way of an email broadcast. Once articles are assigned, articles and accompanying illustrations are emailed to reviewers, and they are given approximately three weeks to complete the review. Guidelines and a response form are provided with each article.
