What is the Harrison Goodall Preservation Fellowship?

This opportunity is aimed at preservation professionals and students enrolled at least part-time in a preservation-related degree program. Federal and non-federal applicants are encouraged to apply.

The Harrison Goodall Preservation Fellowship gives fellows the opportunity to:

- focus on their professional development within historic preservation,
- gain access to networking and resources, and
- learn leadership competencies.

Fellows undertake capstone projects that, through mentorship and coaching, will make a meaningful contribution to the broader historic preservation field and support the stewardship of historic resources nationwide.

The fellowship was inspired by a gift from Harrison Goodall and made possible by Preservation Maryland and its program The Campaign for Historic Trades. The fellowship awards \$10,000 to support an innovative project in the historic preservation field.
