

Title: Architectural Conservator or Preservation Architect

- Perform construction administration services including review of mock-ups and site observation
- Ability to conduct historic finishes testing/analysis is a plus
- Foster client relationships, assist in identifying potential projects, and prepare project proposals
- Stay current with advancements in conservation techniques and materials

Applicant Requirements:

- Master's degree in Architecture or Historic Preservation preferred but equivalent education and experience will be considered
- 4+ years of post-graduate conservation experience
- Knowledge of conservation principles, techniques, and materials
- Proficiency in InDesign, Bluebeam, and MS Office. Knowledge of AutoCAD and/or Revit is a plus
- Ability to travel to onsite projects in the surrounding region and beyond, as required
- Excellent communication, time management, and problem-solving, with the ability to work collaboratively in a team environment
