Description

The Fox Theatre in Atlanta is seeking a qualified candidate for the position of Restoration Technician.

Support the Restoration Manager in maintaining and preserving the historic finishes of the Fox Theatre. This position will support day-to-day restoration activities, including in-house repairs utilizing preservation techniques. The position will also support larger projects and work conducted by Restoration vendors.

Major Responsibilities:

- TECHNICAL PRESERVATION: Assist the Restoration Manager in the care and repair of historic finishes and painted surfaces. Projects will require high competency in the repair of plaster, lath, and decorative faux finishes.
- SPECIAL COLLECTIONS: Assist the Restoration manager with the care of Fox Theatre's historic furniture collection, including routine cleaning, inspections, documentation, and pest management.
- PROJECT DOCUMENTATION: Assist the Restoration Manager with the documentation of preservation projects, including photography and written reports.
- MAINTENANCE: Perform additional non-preservation-related painting duties as required, typically in office or backstage areas.
- Miscellaneous duties to support the work of the Fox Theatre Restoration Department.

Qualifications

Knowledge, Skills, & Qualifications Required:

- Strong interpersonal skills; high proficiency in the repair of decorative plaster and finishes
- Ability to read and interpret standard operating procedures, manuals, schedules, and more
- Proficiency in Microsoft Suite including Office365 and work-order systems
- Detail-oriented and accustomed to multi-tasking; Must be able to lift thirty to fifty pounds.
- Must be able to move, or assist with the move of medium to heavy objects.
- Must be comfortable in work conditions that use scaffolding and ladders.
- Must have an underlying knowledge of historic preservation practices.
- Ability to successfully interface with key vendors and contractors.

Other Requirements:

- Experience in a historic building; familiarity with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties; demonstrated knowledge of project documentation including competent writing skills and basic photography.
- This position requires the employee to be physically on-site to perform their required duties.

- Must be able to lift materials or equipment up to 50 pounds and must be able to pull/push/move up to 100 pounds with assistance if necessary.
